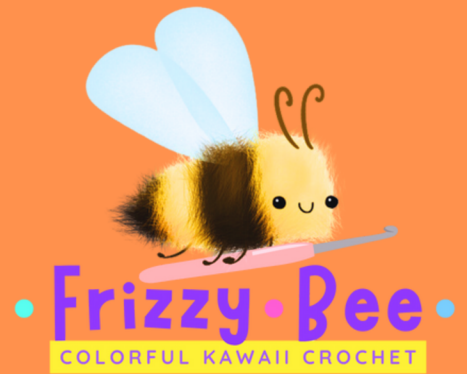

Beginner-Intermediate

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Single Crochet
- Turning Chain

MATERIALS & TOOLS:

- Crochet Hook: 3.5mm
- Yarn 12 Colors Total - (See KEY on p3)
- Stick or Wooden Dowel for decoration
- Buttons (Optional Decoration)
- Sticker Felt Sheet to cut down and put on back side (Optional)
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

- Red Heart Super Saver Yarn Worsted Weight (4-ply)
 - Fiber: Acrylic

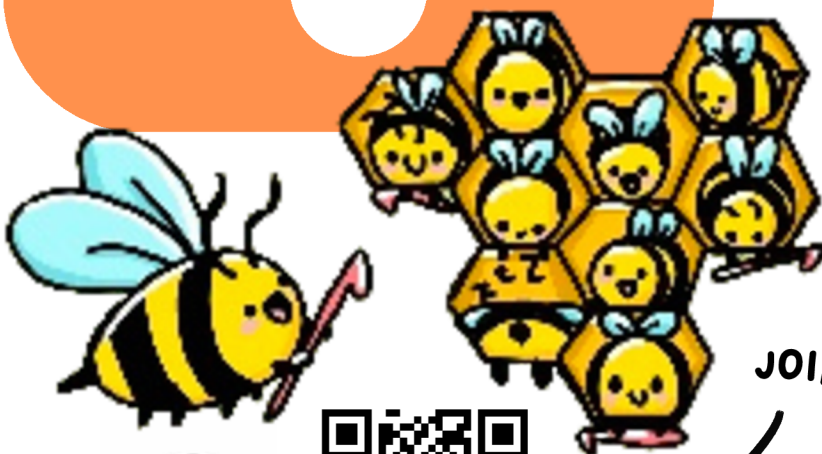
